Section 1, Evaluation of new Steinway model B grand pianos. We are interested in knowing your impressions of New York Steinway model B grand pianos manufactured during approximately the past two years. Therefore, while your impressions of the model B Steinway that you just played should help you in arriving at your evaluations, please answer the questions with regard to all new or nearly new Steinway model B (NY) grands that you have played during the past two years.

- A. Section 3, Predictions of how other people will rate Steinway and Mason & Hamlin seven-foot grand pianos. To determine which participants in this study will receive prizes, we are asking that each participant predict what the average ratings will be across all participants in the study. For example, the first prize will be awarded to the participant who most closely predicts the average ratings for overall quality of Mason & Hamlin model BB grands and New York Steinway model B grands; the second prize will be awarded to the participant who most closely predicts the average rating for tone quality of these two pianos, and so on. The manner in which the prizes shall be awarded is described in detail in the endnote vi, entitled "Awarding of Prizes".

With regard to each of the items below, please provide your best guess, to the nearest tenth of a point, as to what the average rating will be across all 300 participants in this study. For example, if you feel that the average score for a given item will be about 75, you should refine your guess more precisely (such as, for example, to 75.3 or 74.8). If you feel that the average score for the item will be exactly 75, please write your prediction as 75.0. Be sure to provide a best guess for each item. Participants providing incomplete questionnaires will be ineligible for prizes.
